The Chapel's Outreach Foundation, Inc., in partnership with CareerSource Capital Region, is pleased to present the Summer Employment Program, a structured workforce development initiative designed to equip youth and young adults (ages 16–21) with the skills, experience, and exposure necessary for long-term career success. This program is intentionally designed to bridge the gap between education and employment by combining paid work experience with formal workforce training and mentorship.

Participant Experience Includes:

Hands-On Work Experience with Local Employers: Participants are placed with vetted local businesses and organizations, where they gain practical, real-world experience in professional settings. This exposure helps develop workplace etiquette, accountability, and job-specific competencies.

Weekly Workforce Development Training: Participants attend structured in-service sessions focused on essential career skills such as communication, professionalism, leadership, and workplace readiness.

Financial Literacy and Career Readiness Education: Through guided instruction and interactive learning, participants build foundational knowledge in budgeting, saving, credit management, and long-term financial planning, skills critical for economic independence.

Professional Exposure and Mentorship: Participants benefit from direct engagement with business leaders and professionals who provide mentorship, career insight, and encouragement, helping to shape their future aspirations.

This comprehensive approach ensures that participants are not only employed for the summer but are also prepared for sustainable career pathways and lifelong success.

WHAT YOUR SUPPORT MAKES POSSIBLE

Your investment directly contributes to measurable outcomes that impact both participants and the broader community:

Expanding Access to Paid Employment Opportunities for Youth: Sponsor support directly funds meaningful, paid work experiences for youth and young adults ages 16-21, enabling participants to earn \$15/hour. This translates into real income that supports families, reduces financial barriers, and introduces participants to the dignity and discipline of work. While current program-year wages are supported through grant funding, sponsor contributions are essential to sustaining and expanding these paid employment opportunities for Summer 2027 and beyond, ensuring program continuity in years when grant funding may be limited or unavailable. Each sponsored placement represents a tangible investment in a young person's economic stability and future career pathway.

Supporting Program Materials and Participant Resources: Sponsor funding helps provide essential program materials such as training supplies, printed resources, and participant handbooks. These materials enhance the learning experience and ensure participants are equipped with tools they need to succeed during and after the program.

Delivering Structured, High-Impact Workforce Training: Sponsorships make it possible to provide hands-on workforce development sessions in partnership with professional development and workforce development partners. These in-service training courses focus on measurable skill-building outcomes such as resume development, interview readiness, workplace communication, and digital literacy, ensuring that every participant leaves the program with practical, job-ready competencies that can be immediately applied.

Program Staffing and Dedicated Coordination: Sponsor support makes it possible to fund program coordinators, facilitators, and administrative staff who manage day-to-day operations, oversee participant progress, coordinate employer placement, and ensure a high-quality experience for all stakeholders. Strong staffing is critical to scaling the program effectively and maintaining consistency.

Participant Recruitment and Outreach Efforts: Sponsor funding supports targeted outreach strategies to reach eligible youth across the community, including marketing materials, information sessions, digital campaigns and community engagement efforts. This ensures the program attracts a diverse and qualified pool of participants each year.

Program Expansion and Scalability: Sponsor funding allows the Foundation to increase the number of youth served, expand into additional industries or sectors, and grow the program's reach in future years. This scalability ensures more young people benefit from workforce opportunities over time.
